





Caldwell Park

Located next to the Sacramento River, Caldwell Park offers "Jump River," a play area for children under 5 years old; Redding Skate Park, a 20,500 sq. ft. outdoor structure featuring 3 large bowls, 1 low rail, 1 high rail, 1 half pipe, and a vertical wall (also used for BMX practice); a Rec Center, Teen Center, and art gallery; soccer fields; fish viewing facility, and art walk.



Enterprise Park

Home of Kid's Kingdon and Fantasy Fountain, Enterprise Park features a water volcano that erupts every 6 minutes, a large, shaded children's play area, picnic pavillion, outdoor roller hockey rink, soccer fields, basketball courts, and Redding's only discgolf course. The park is also home to a Community Center and Community Garden.



A trip to Shasta Caverns is "Three Adventures in One!" Enjoy a scenic catamaran cruise across Shasta Lake, a fun bus ride to the cave entrance, and an information-filled tour of what some geologists consider one of the most beautiful limestone caves in the Nation! The trip into the caverns involves some great exercise--first walking a winding trail to/from the boat, and then walking up and down several hundred stairs inside the caverns. 

Shasta Lake and Shasta Dam

Shasta Lake, the largest lake in California, offers over 360 miles of shoreline, making it easy to find your own little piece of paradise on a houseboat, ski boat, or waverunner. Public and private boat ramps, campgrounds, resorts and marinas are abundant and rentals are available. Shasta Dam, the second largest dam in mass in the United States, includes a Visitor Center that features a movie about the dam's construction and offers free public tours.

Shasta State Historic Park

Old Shasta's historic brick buildings mark the location where the area's "Queen City" once stood during northern California's gold mining days. The park features an excellent museum that is still home to the original jail and gallows. The Litsch General Store and the Blumb Bakery have been restored to their original condition. Other historical sites include one of the oldest Masonic Lodges in California.


Sundial Bridge at Turtle Bay

This incredible glass decked pedestrian bridge links the north and south campuses of Turtle Bay Exploration Park and serves as an entrance for Redding's Sacramento River National Recreation Trail. The unique design of the bridge was conceived by world renowned Spanish architect Santiago Calatrava. It is the first bridge of its kind in the United States, and is the largest working sundial in the world! The massive 210' pylon leans due north and functions as the gnomon of a sundial, casting its giant shadow on a gardenbordered dial plate at the bridge's north end. The tall pylon and cable stays allow the bridge to avoid nearby sensitive salmonspawning habitat while encouraging public appreciation for the river.

Whiskeytown National Recreation Area

This beautiful park features cool rugged canyons, forests, yearround streams, and, of course,

Whiskeytown Lake. Sandy beaches, marinas, camping facilities, excellent sailing and fishing, plus numerous marked hiking and mountain biking trails make this park a favorite for visitors and locals alike. Situated on the south shore of the lake is a memorial to President John F. Kennedy, commemorating his dedication of the dam in 1963, shortly before his assassination. Whiskeytown has four major waterfalls you can visit all year. One of these--the 220-foot cascading Whiskeytown Falls--was recently rediscovered, making it the region's tallest waterfall.

Presenting the Vineyards and Wineries of the North State

More than a dozen vineyards and wineries dot the landscape in and around Redding. The area possesses a unique combination of soil and mountain climate which imparts a vibrant character to the grapes grown here. Castle Crags State Park

Named for the 225 million-year-old, 6,000-foot tall glacierpolished crags, this beautiful state park offers swimming and fishing in the Sacramento River, hiking in the back country, and a great view of Mt. Shasta. There are 76 developed campsites and 6 environmental campsites. RV camping up to 27' is available. The 4,350-acre park features 28 miles of hiking trails, including a 2.7 mile access trail to Castle Crags wilderness, part of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. The Pacific Crest Trail also passes through the park.

Lassen Volcanic National Park

Less than an hour's drive from Redding sits beautiful Lassen Volcanic National Park. The park boasts incredible mountain scenery reminiscent of Yosemite as well as fascinating thermal wonders similar to Yellowstone with just a small fraction of the visitors. Lassen features three of the four different types of geothermal features including steam vents, mudpots, and hot springs; all four types of volcanoes (shield, plug dome, cinder cone, and composite); and all types of naturally occurring lakes! Near Lassen Peak, the road reaches 8,512 feet, making it the highest road in the Cascade Mountain range. The park is open

is usually limited from December - May. Excellent cross-country skiing is available, as well as interpretive snowshoe tours led by park rangers. During the warm summer months in Redding, visit this spectacular park to experience spring all over again!

McArthur-Burney Falls Memorial State Park

Spectacular 129-foot Burney Falls can be enjoyed from the top at the lookout point; but for a more refreshing experience, take the trail to the pool at the base of the falls and along the stream. Excellent camping is available, with 118 campsites, newly constructed restroom facilities, hot water showers, stoves, tables, and food lockers. A boat ramp is also available at nearby Lake Britton.



There are five miles of hiking trails winding through the park's evergreen forests, and the Pacific Crest Trail passes right through the park!





SCENIC DRIVES & BACK COUNTRY ROADS

Redding is THE place to start your scenic drive or off-road adventure! Looking for a great place to get away in your RV? The Shasta Cascade Wonderland Association, in cooperation with the United States Forest Service, has created a brochure that breaks the area's scenic byways down into distance, minimum driving time, best time to go, what to see along the way, and services along the route. One of only two All American Roads in California-the Volcanic Legacy Scenic Byway



is located right in Redding's back yard!

Off-roading is also popular here, and there are a number of scenic trails that will challenge your vehicle's 4-wheel drive, leaving your car dusty but not scratched. This 1870s Chinese Taoist Temple is the oldest continuously active Chinese temple in California. Art objects, pictures, mining tools, and weapons used in the 1854 Tong War are on display. Still a place of worship, the temple offers a fascinating look into the role played by Chinese immigrants in early California history.






